

Ioannis Paraschis, Former CEO, Athens International Airport

Ioannis Paraschis was the Managing Director of Athens International Airport S.A. (AIA) since February 2024, the Chief Executive Officer since May 2007 and the Chairman of the Board of Executives of AIA since 2007. He served as the Company's Deputy Chief Executive Officer from January 2002 to April 2007. He joined AIA following an international career in academia and management consulting with A.T. Kearney and Deloitte. Mr. Paraschis serves on several boards and councils of companies, academic institutions and trade associations in Greece and abroad, including: President of the Greek Tourism Confederation (SETE) since June 2023, member of the Board of ACI EUROPE, which he chaired from 2007 to 2009, member of the World Governing Board of ACI until December 2024 (Chairman 2011 – 2013), member of the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of the Foundation for Economic & Industrial Research (IOBE), Chair of the Greek Council of the Sustainable Markets Initiative (Terra Carta) and a member of the Board of Directors of Marketing Greece S.A. since 2013. Mr. Paraschis was honored in October 2015 with the first "CAPA Airport Chief Executive of the Year" award. He holds a Master's in Industrial Engineering and a PhD in Operations Research from the University of Hamburg, Germany. Mr. Paraschis is a Chartered Engineer, qualified in 1986 from the Technical Chamber of Greece.
